

The Basics







Information Gathering / Build Strategy

- What types of forms are being built?
 - Assessment forms
 - Define "All Normal" controls for Physical Exam or ROS forms
- What types of users are the form(s) being built for?
- Use Allscripts delivered note forms
- Gather paper or electronic forms
- Set expectations

Complex Sentences

Qualifiers

- Qualifiers are used to determine the placement of the rendered text at a Control property level or at the Header placed on a Detail Form. The Qualifier options are <u>Prefix</u>, <u>Insert</u>, <u>Suffix</u>, or <u>None</u>.
- If the Qualifier is set to <u>Insert</u>, the render text of the control will render where the ~M is present in the render text.
- <u>Prefix</u> renders text at the beginning of the sentence
- <u>Suffix</u> renders text at the end of the sentence
- Examples





Complex Sentences...

Values (~V)

- Inserts the value entered.
- ~V is used to provide a Text Entry space.
- Display name must have three underscores ("___") to properly render the value

Units (~U)

- Inserts the unit of measure.
- ~U is used with ~V to indicate specific units of measure.
- ~V ~Ucm will render "5 cm"
- If no value is entered, the unit of measure will not render.

Exclusive/Inclusive Controls

Mutually Exclusive Controls (Radio Groups)

Radio Groups – When multiple choices are present with only one potential selection

Potentially Inclusive Controls

- Y/N
- Checkboxes
- Radio controls (outside of radio groups)
- +/-
- Examples

Tips & Tricks

- Recycle your Document Types
- When to use Reverse Meaning
- Elaborating on findings with no detail forms (double click)
- Hidden headings/groups (avoid if possible)
- Continuation training for providers should help decrease long term maintenance of forms & note components
