What is the Health Management Plan?

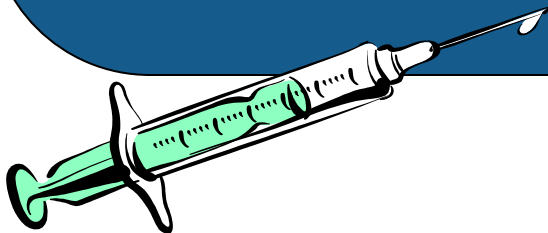
- Tool used to prescribe and monitor events related to a patient's Health Maintenance and disease management.
- Divided into 6 Main Components:
 - Health Management Plan
 - Reminders/Alerts
 - Flowsheets
 - Normative Growth Chart
 - Immunizations
 - Vitals Signs

SCENARIO

Dr. Bones is reviewing the patient's treatment for Asthma. He wants to know when the patient's last Influenza vaccine was given and when the next influenza vaccine is due. If it is overdue, he will administer the vaccine today.

Dr. Bones also wants to order a PT/INR for the patient's Coronary Artery Disease and schedule it to generate an order for the patient every month for 6 months.

Dr. Bones ordered the patient's sigmoidoscopy last visit and received the results today. He wants to complete the order and set a reminder for the patient to have this procedure done every 5 years.



SCENARIO

Dr. Bones's next patient is a 35 year-old female who is coming in for a physical exam. The patient needs to start getting yearly Colonoscopies, starting this year, for preventative care.

Dr. Bones also wants to set a reminder for the patient to have a Mammogram when she turns 40.

The patient is diagnosed with Pernicious Anemia and needs to receive monthly B-12 injections. Dr. Bones would like to give the first injection today and set a monthly reminder for the additional injections.



What's New in 11.2 HMP?


11.1.7 → 11.2

- ALL problems aren't displayed anymore
- Filters can be used to display only desired items
- Can personalize preferences
- Problems are now actionable from HMP in same way as from Problem component
- Medications are now 'Other' instead of 'Unassigned'
- Can now link other meds/other orders to one or more active problems directly from the HMP
- Can create reminders by right-clicking in 'To Do' column
- Create reminder button can be added to HMP

Let's review some of these **NEW** features

HMP Enterprise Preferences

- Access via TWAdmin → Preferences → HMP
- Several preferences that control what items display in the Health Management view and how those items are sorted.
- The Application Design and Behavior Resource (ABDR) has detailed information on each preference. This resource can be found under Allscripts Documentation in SupportForce.


